本校自103年起,即與大阪府立千里高校 (Senri Senior High School) 建立雙方互訪,實質科學文化交流的夥伴關係,在互訪活動中,蒙千里高校 爭取日本政府JST櫻花科學計畫補助 (Japan Science and Technology Agency), 連續多年提供本校師生公費赴日見學交流, 期間有寄宿家庭體 驗、入班觀察學習、參與科學交流等活動,強化兩校的夥伴互動。

今年10月14-20日,英文科林建宏老師帶領8位學生前往千里高校參加櫻 花科學週相關活動,12月25-28日千里高校西澤淳夫(Nishizawa Atsuo) 和北 澤美樹(Kitazawa Miki)2位老師與15位學生蒞臨本校進行科學與文化交流, 歡迎儀式中,兩校學生分別介紹自己生活中的文化特色。參訪期間,正逢學 校一年一度的冬至聯誼會,亦一併邀請千里師生品嚐美味的佳餚與湯圓。科 學交流部分,雙方學生以英文進行專題發表,彼此交流對談科學實驗的研究

過程與成果;還有入班上課,實際參與高中部、雙語部的自然人文與環境科 學課程,以及安排桌球、羽球友誼賽。另外,感謝科技部中部科學園區管理 局協助導覽園區、史料館與探訪東海大學,讓兩校師生認識中部科學園區的 各種產業,以及如何創造高科技產業優質之環境,帶動科技產業技術之升級 與發展。

四天三夜的寄宿家庭體驗,道別時,千里高校學生彈唱《昂首向前走》 (上を向いて歩こう)歌曲感謝,特別是接待友伴間的擁抱與不捨,更增進 雙方夥伴學校間的情誼。除了科學交流,兩校也正進行跨國微辯論交流。雙 方突破空間障礙,同步進行議題探討,中科實中的國際交流活動不僅增進學 生外語學習能力,同時也提升學生的國際行動力,在潛移默化中培養多元文 化觀,深化拓展寰宇視野。

A Unique and Memorable Experience (Japan Science and Technology Agency 9 JST)

This seven-day trip was a unique and memorable experience. I was lucky to have this great opportunity. I learned a lot during my time in Japan.

The most valuable experience I had was having a homestay. In my host family, I could learn Japanese culture, enjoy Japanese food and lifestyle. There were 6 people in my homestay family, including my host, my host's parents, brother, and two grandmothers. They all showed me great hospitality and treated me very well. We talked a lot and I learned many things from them. They also took me to several restaurants to have traditional Japanese dishes such as okonomiyaki and sumo wrestler hot pot. The host family I had this time was quite different from other Japanese families because the host's dad was not Japanese, and they had lived in the US for ten years before they went back to Japan. They could speak English fluently, so I didn't have to worry about the language problem. Another unforgettable experience I had was visiting a Japanese high school. I interacted with the students there and had classes for a whole day. It was worth it to make friends and experience different teaching ways. The most important part of this trip was the symposium. I was assigned to present the environmental issue in Taiwan. I was really proud of myself that I had the courage to stand in front of hundreds of people. Even though the presentation was only three minutes long, it was still deeply meaningful to me. Besides, I learned a lot from other presenters, and it was obvious that everyone put lots of effort into their presentations. Except for staying at school, the school arranged tours to some research centers. Japan is leading in scientific research in the world and a lot of Nobel Prize receivers are from Japan. It was a memorable experience. This was the first time that I went into the labs to see how professional scientists do research. The thing that impressed me the most was the robotics research center at Osaka University. I got to see the most advanced artificial intelligence robots. Each type of robot has different functions. Some robots are practical, and some are for entertaining people.

This trip to Japan was amazing. I've already been to Japan many times, but the experience I had this time was very different. I hope I can visit Japan for educational purposes in the future. Moreover, I will be the host of my Japan host next month when they visit Taiwan. I will take him to many places and help him explore Taiwanese culture.

新課綱二外成發聖誕派對 實中人跨國界外語多聲帶

108年新課綱今年甫上路,實中延續國際化新願景,將第二外語納入校訂必修課程,高一每週安排2小時二外課程,學校則是提供五種二外課程,讓學生從其中擇其所好學習。不僅有新南向正夯的印尼語、越南語,也開設近年來流行的日德西語課程,在經將近40小時學習後,各個外語班級在本校小舞台齊聚,於12月25日早上進行二外成果發表聖誕派對,創意展現這半年二外學習的成果。

首先歌舞擂台邀請各個二外課程,表演該二外耶誕冬季歌曲或是重要節慶音樂,日語班透過音樂劇,生動重現冰雪情緣經典劇情,台下一同參與國中學生不禁哄堂大笑,現場洋溢熱鬧歡樂的氣氛;德語組也重現冰雪奇緣經典橋段,透過短劇表演,讓現場師生重溫電影音樂旋律及精彩片段;印語組則是表演安格隆竹筒琴,藉由竹筒搖晃發出優美旋律,讓現場充滿著濃厚的南洋味;越語組透過歌舞,展現越南年味,熱鬧歡騰的流行音樂、喜氣滿溢的紅色春聯,頗有提前過年氛圍;最後則由日語組學生演唱流行歌曲,為今年歌舞表演畫下完美的句點。

此外,文化闖關活動讓各班級發揮巧思佈置,除了讓學生複習已學的外語文化,更能讓其他學生體驗其語文差異,增進文化理解能力,提升個人文化涵養。本次五種外語課程共設有六種文化關卡,包括越南春聯初體驗、印尼樂器停看聽、德國飲食大不同、日本地圖野球手、西語國旗配對趣、日語旅遊夯景點。負責統籌本次活動的教務處王亞喬主任表示:「實中今年特別為了新課綱上路的第一屆高一學生,舉辦第二外語成果發表活動,學生的表現充分展現出中科實中的學校願景「展能、活力、國際化」。學生不僅在二外課程中學習語言,同時也學習文化的理解與包容,當看到印尼語課程的同學表演Angklung(印尼竹筒樂器)時,讓我深深感受到孩子的認真與老師的用心。」

2019年二外成果發表聖誕派對歌舞擂台及文化闖關,充分展現實中人外語多聲帶國際化特色!高中部學生透過第二外語學習,增進文化理解、提升文化涵養;配合既有英文課程國際專案、外師融入教學活動,讓外語學習更具生活情境,全面提升學生外語溝通能力。此外,每年更有多次機會,能與國際友校跨國交流,不管是日德短期交換或國際跨校視訊,學生橫跨歐亞暢所無阻,有效培養實中學生成為未來國際行動人才!



I'm happy to be here!

I signed my contract to come to Taiwan and be a part of IBSC in February of last year. Previous to that, I have taught Special Education and Social Studies for 7 years in the United States. Things are very different here, from both cultural and pedagogical standpoints. It has been an enjoyable adventure seeing and learning about the culture and teaching in Taiwan.

Culturally, being a student and teacher of the social sciences, I had already done a fair bit of research about Taiwan before I landed. I watched videos, read articles, and asked what questions I could of people that might know something about the place I was going to. Everyone raved about the great food, and friendly attitude of the Taiwanesse people. I was very happy to experience these things first-hand. I really don't know what you make up the famous 5 spice blend that you guys put on everything, but I love it! I also really appreciate that I can walk just about anywhere alone, even at night, without fear of crime, definitely something I could not do in the USA. When I see people on the street, most are happy to return my greetings of "Hello! And Good Morning!"

Pedagogically, teaching feels much "easier" here. My students in both my international classes, and my ESL classes, are all hard workers. They are well-behaved and respectful. Their memorization skills, and willingness to perform tasks without questioning why they have been given are refreshing. In the United States, my students had relatively strong critical thinking and problem-solving skills, but they would also always question why they were given certain tasks, and might refuse to do something if they didn't believe it was "worth their time." My new students seem to especially appreciate differentiation in my instruction, and are always willing to try new things.

The school day is also very different. In the US, teachers were expected to be at their classroom (in the US, teachers stay in their classroom, and the students change classes every period) by 7:30, with classes starting at 8:00. There is a half-hour for lunch, and no rest time. Time between classes is 4

minutes, not 10. Class ends at 3:16 at my old school, with the teachers being allowed to leave at 3:30. Despite the somewhat shorter day, teachers are all expected to teach in their classroom for 6 class periods each day. In contrast, I teach 23 classes per week, though 7 of these classes are considered "extra" in the terms of my contract. There is no homeroom in the US, and many of the tasks performed by homeroom teachers in Taiwan are performed by office staff. Discipline is handled directly by subject teachers, or the Dean of Discipline, if it becomes necessary. Disruptive students are removed from class, and have disciplinary referrals written for them that stay in their academic record for the entirety of their academic careers. I see students sometimes posted outside of the teachers offices for disciplinary reasons here, but have never had to punish a student beyond a verbal scolding in Taiwan.

Extracurricular activities are also different. In the US, many students will participate in sports, or clubs after school. The clubs are not a part of the school day as they are here, rather, they are "extra" activities that students can choose to participate in, or go home. Sports teams from schools in smaller communities are often a point of pride for the community, with many members of the community who don't have children at the school attending games and competitions for entertainment.

Perhaps the biggest difference is the respect that teachers are given in Taiwan. In the United States, teaching is considered an honorable profession, but also viewed as something "anyone" can do, and not worthy of extra respect or expertise. Consequently, parents are likely to argue with teachers over grades or discipline, and will demand changes on the part of teachers before demanding changes from their children. Because teachers are not viewed with the same respect in the US, they are often blamed for the shortcomings of the students, and held accountable for problems beyond their control. It is not unheard of for a parent to blame a teacher for their child's poor performance on an exam rather than the student's poor study habits.

I am much happier in Taiwan. My job feels less stressful, my students have better attitudes, and the entire atmosphere here is more constructive. Thank you for having me! If you see me walking on the campus, please don't be afraid to say "Hello." I will be sure to reciprocate with a smile!
