Educational Goals

- 1.To educate students in civics and morality.
- 2.To educate students on cultural awareness and sensitivity.
- 3.To enrich the knowledge of students.
- 4.To develop the fundamental scholastic ability of students.
- 5. To develop the physical strength of students.
- 6.To develop a good work ethic in students.
- 7. To develop team spirit in students.
- 8.To inspire the artistic interest of students.

School History

- 1917 The Taiwan Governor's Office established the Tainan Girls' High School to recruit Japanese students.
- 1921 The Tainan Prefecture Tainan Girls' General High School was established to recruit Taiwanese students.
- 1922 The name of the Tainan Girls' High School was changed to the Tainan Prefecture Tainan First Girls' High School; the Tainan Prefecture Tainan Girls' General High School was changed to the Tainan Prefecture Tainan Second Girls' High School.
- 1945 The name of the Tainan Prefecture Tainan First Girls' High School was changed to the Taiwan Provincial Tainan Second Girls' High School; the Tainan Prefecture Tainan Second Girls' High School was changed to the Taiwan Provincial Tainan First Girls' High School.
- 1947 Both school merged and became the Taiwan Provincial Tainan Girls' High School offering a six-year high school program.
- 1961 The junior high school section was shut down according to the "provincial government for senior high schools and county government for junior high schools" policy.
- 1970 The name of the school was changed to the Taiwan Provincial Tainan Girls' Senior High School.
- 1971 Opened the open subsidiary school with a three-year program for general senior high school. The open subsidiary school was shut down in 1975.
- 1979 The Senior Student System was established and has since become an excellent TNGS tradition.
- 1984 Opened the Special Class for Music (also recruits boys).
- 1987 Opened the Special Class for Mathematics and Science.
- 2000 The name of the school was changed to National Tainan Girls' Senior High School under the central government after a government restructuring in Taiwan.
- 2004 Opened the Special Class for English.
- 2009 The Special Class for English was transformed into the Social Studies Class.



Curriculum Planning



Regular Class (48 classes, each 42 students)

- Teaching Excellence Program and Grade 12 Revision Program are planned and designed to provide students advanced learning and guidance for further studies.
- Tutors are arranged in the evening to help students solve academic problems.

Special Class for Math and Science (3 classes, each 30 students)

- The aim of the math and science gifted class is to develop the abilities of students gifted in mathematics and natural sciences and prepare them for scholastic ability competitions and the International Mathematics Olympiad.
- With the focus on mathematics and science seminars and thematic independent research, the math and science gifted class provides advanced education for fundamental subjects to help students reach their self-potential.
- ln addition to collaborative teaching with universities for various research projects, the math and science gifted class enrolls Fundamental Talent Cultivation Program for Senior High School Students.

Special Class for English (transformed into the Social Studies Class since 2009) (3 classes, each 30 students)

- Aiming to cultivate the language ability of students gifted in English, the English gifted class provides students the opportunity to read selected English novels and English speech training; it employs foreign teachers to enhance language learning efficacy.
- The Introduction to Social Studies and Social Studies Classics Reading courses are planned and designed to develop the humanities literacy of students.

Special Class for Music (3 classes, each 30 students)

- ln order to foster students gifted in music, master classes are organized at times.
- Musicians holding a master's degree or higher degree are hired to give individual lessons to students in order to sharpen their techniques.
- Student concerts, graduation concerts and inter-school concerts are held regularly to provide students practical and learning opportunities.

Faculty and Facility

- © Counseling training courses are organized for teachers to improve their counseling competence and thereby help students grow and develop.
- TNGS equips all classrooms with computers, large-screen LCD Tvs and electric screens to facilitate multimedia-assisted instruction.
- TNGS has well-equipped computer and optoelectronic laboratories and other facilities, including professional microscopes used in observatories and research institutions.
- There are 36 practice rooms equipped pianos, a concert hall and a wide range of musical instruments for the music gifted class.
- The multimedia IT center is equipped with a digital TV editing system and plotter for producing digital movies.
- TNGS has well-equipped subject classrooms to meet the special needs of each subject.

Foreign visits and student exchanges are arranged for students to connect them with the world and to help them develop international competiveness.







Student Counseling


- Orientation guidance is provided for new students to help them adjust to senior high school life.




